PUBLIC CONTRACTS. Provides for the procurement of materials and goods. (8/1/26)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 38:2212.1(O), relative to procurement requirements for materials
3 and goods by public entities; to provide for the purchase of certain non new rail
4 equipment; to provide for the purchase of related parts by a railroad operated or
5 owned by a political subdivision; to provide for exemptions; and to provide for
6 related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 38:2212.1(O) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §2212.1. Advertisement and letting to lowest responsible bidder; materials and
10 supplies; exemptions

11 * * *

12 O. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to **any of the following**:

13 **(1) The** purchase of animals trained to perform special tasks, including but
14 not limited to narcotics detection, bomb detection, arson investigation, and rescue
15 techniques by the following public entities:

16 ~~(a)~~**(a)** Any local law enforcement agency for the principal purpose of aiding
17 in the detection of criminal activity, enforcement of laws, or apprehension of

1 offenders.

2 ~~(2)~~**(b)** Any local public safety agency for the purpose of search and rescue
3 services.

4 **(2) Purchases by a political subdivision that owns or operates a railroad**
5 **of any of the following:**

6 **(a) Used locomotives and its component parts.**

7 **(b) On-track equipment and its component parts.**

8 **(c) Other rolling stock and its component parts.**

9 **(d) Track maintenance equipment and its attachments.**

Present law provides for requirements for advertisement and letting to lowest responsible bidder for materials and supplies and exemptions of purchases paid out of public funds.

Present law further provides for an exemption for animals trained to perform special tasks, including narcotics and bomb detection, arson investigation, and rescue techniques by law enforcement or any local public safety agency for specific services.

Proposed law provides for exemptions for a political subdivision that own or operate a railroad for the purchase of the following and its component parts: used locomotives, on-track equipment, and other rolling stock, and track maintenance equipment and its attachments.

Effective August 1, 2026.
