Morris

Present law prohibits any person holding an alcoholic beverage retail dealer's permit of high or low alcoholic content, and any person permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers, including their agents, associates, employees, representatives, or servants from intentionally enticing, aiding, or permitting any person under the age of 18 years from visiting or loitering in or about any place where alcoholic beverages or beer are the principal commodities sold, handled, or given away.

Proposed law retains present law and adds locations where consumable hemp products are sold, handled, or given away, to the list of locations where persons under the age of 18 years are prohibited from visiting or loitering.

Effective August 1, 2026.
