Abstract: Requires cell cultured food products contain a disclosure identifying the product in a clear and conspicuous manner.

Present law prohibits any person from intentionally misbranding or misrepresenting certain food products as an agricultural product through various activities, including intentionally misbranding or representing a cell cultured food product as a meat product.

Proposed law retains present law and further requires that any cell cultured food product bear a clear and conspicuous disclosure identifying the product in a bold typed print of not less than 30-point font.
