1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "liability;" and before "and" insert "to provide for severability;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 2, line 4, delete "natural"5 AMENDMENT NO. 36 On page 2, line 5, delete "residential"7 AMENDMENT NO. 48 On page 2, line 12, delete "residential"9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 2, after line 29, add the following:

11 "D. Any broadband or cable service provider that complies with applicable  
12 federal disclosure requirements, including the Federal Communications  
13 Commission's broadband consumer label requirements, shall be deemed in  
14 compliance with the disclosure requirements of this Chapter, if such disclosures are  
15 made available to consumers in this state."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 617 On page 3, line 1, change "D." to "E."18 AMENDMENT NO. 719 On page 3, line 21, after "exists," and before "notice" insert "written"20 AMENDMENT NO. 821 On page 3, line 28, change "51:1384" to "51:1383"22 AMENDMENT NO. 9

23 On page 5, between lines 7 and 8 insert the following:

24 "Section 3. All disclosures required pursuant to this Act shall be limited to factual,  
25 objective, and non-controversial commercial information reasonably related to the state's  
26 interest in preventing consumer deception and promoting transparency.

27 Section 4. This Act shall apply only to consumer protection and disclosure practices  
28 affecting customers within this state and shall not be construed to regulate interstate  
29 communications services in a manner inconsistent with federal law.

30 Section 5. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof is held invalid, such  
31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given  
32 effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this  
33 Act are hereby declared severable."
