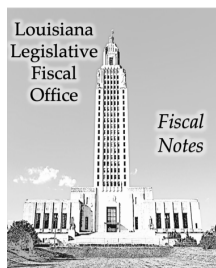

Proposed legislation expands present law requirements governing health services provided on school campuses to include primary health services in addition to the currently allowed behavioral health services. Extends existing procedural protections and requirements for behavioral health providers to primary health providers, including parental request, provider licensure, criminal background checks, parental choice of provider, provision during school hours, coordination with student plans, and rulemaking oversight by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE). Requires governing authorities to adopt a written policy implementing these provisions for both behavioral and primary health services. Mandates that any costs associated with providing these services are the responsibility of the parent or their third-party payor, including private insurance or Medicaid.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation is expected to result in increased administrative workload and potentially increased costs for local public school systems. Expanding health services eligible for provision on public school campuses will require public school systems to coordinate with additional third-party providers, arrange for the provision of services during instructional time, verify provider credentials and student insurance, ensure compliance with student privacy requirements, and align services with existing student plans (e.g., IEPs, 504 plans, and Individualized Health Plans). While similar processes currently exist for behavioral health services, expansion to additional providers may increase the volume and complexity of these activities.

To the extent these responsibilities cannot be absorbed within existing staff, some school systems may incur additional costs for personnel, such as nursing staff or program coordinators. Any such costs, if realized, are indeterminable and expected to vary by school system.

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) indicates that any additional administrative responsibilities at the state level can be absorbed within existing resources and staffing levels.

Note: The cost of services provided by health care providers is borne by parents/guardians or third-party payors (e.g., Medicaid or commercial insurance), and not by state or local education agencies.
