SENATE BILL NO. 141

COURTS. Provides that activities of the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board be performed by the Louisiana Supreme Court. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:1228 and 1228.5(4), relative to the Integrated Criminal
3 Justice Information System Policy Board; to provide for jurisdiction and
4 administration of the board by the supreme court; to provide for an effective date;
5 and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 15:1228 and 1228.5(4) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8 follows:

9 §1228. Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board

10 The Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board, hereinafter
11 known as "policy board", is established under the jurisdiction of the Louisiana
12 ~~Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, office of~~
13 ~~the governor~~ **Supreme Court**.

15 §1228.5. Officers; meetings

16 The organization of the policy board shall be as follows:

17 * * *

1 (4) The Louisiana ~~Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of~~
 2 ~~Criminal Justice~~ **Supreme Court** shall provide to the policy board such clerical,
 3 professional, or technical staff as the policy board may require in the performance
 4 of its duties. The policy board, with the concurrence of the chief executive officer of
 5 the agency involved, may require additional personnel or technical assistance on a
 6 temporary basis from any unit of the executive branch of state government.

7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
 11 effective on the day following such approval.

Present law establishes the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board (policy board) under the jurisdiction of the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, office of the governor (commission).

Proposed law places the policy board under the jurisdiction of the La. Supreme Court.

Present law requires that the commission provide for clerical, professional, or technical staff as the policy board may require. Authorizes the policy board, with the concurrence of the chief executive officer of the agency involved, to require additional personnel or technical assistance on a temporary basis from any unit of the executive branch of state government.

Proposed law provides that the present law functions of the commission relative to the policy board be performed by the La. Supreme Court.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
