A RESOLUTION

To commend Film Louisiana for its significant contributions to the economic development and cultural vitality of Louisiana and to designate Wednesday, April 15, 2026, as Film Louisiana Day at the state capitol.

WHEREAS, Film Louisiana is a statewide trade association representing the motion picture, television, and digital media production industry; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana has earned national and international recognition as a premier destination for film and television production and is commonly known as "Hollywood South" due to its diverse locations, skilled workforce, and well-developed production infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Film Louisiana plays a vital role in advocating for policies that support and sustain the continued growth of Louisiana's film industry and helps to attract major productions and long-term investment to the state; and

WHEREAS, the film and television industry provides substantial economic benefits to Louisiana by creating thousands of jobs for residents, supporting local businesses, and generating significant economic activity throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, Film Louisiana actively promotes workforce development, fosters local talent, and strengthens collaboration between industry professionals and state leaders; and

WHEREAS, Film Louisiana Day at the state capitol provides an important opportunity for members of the film industry to engage with legislators, highlight their contributions, and emphasize the importance of maintaining a strong and competitive film sector in Louisiana.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Film Louisiana for its contributions to the economic prosperity and cultural enrichment of the state and does hereby designate Wednesday, April 15, 2026, as Film Louisiana Day at the state capitol.
