1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Charles  
3 Wilson.

4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of  
5 Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana has learned of the passing, on April 3, 2026,  
6 of Charles Wiley Wilson; and

7 WHEREAS, Charles Wiley Wilson was born on March 13, 1941, to Ozeale "Mudge"  
8 Hall and Charles Wesley "Paw-Paw Pete" Wilson; he was a native of Delhi, Louisiana, and  
9 was raised in a hard-working farming family from whom he inherited a legacy of resilience  
10 and a deep devotion to family; and

11 WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, Mr. Wilson attended Northeast  
12 Louisiana State College in Monroe, Louisiana, where he earned a bachelor of science degree  
13 in agriculture; he went on to complete a master of science degree in agriculture at Louisiana  
14 State University in Baton Rouge; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson worked as a county extension agent for more than thirty-  
16 five years; he served in East Carroll, Texas, and provided more than twenty-five years of  
17 service in West Feliciana Parish; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson was a forestry expert, skilled woodworker, dedicated youth  
19 baseball coach, and loyal LSU fan; he was a fifty-year Mason of Feliciana Lodge #31 and  
20 an avid outdoorsman who cherished hunting, fishing, and gardening; he also loved to cook,  
21 especially while sharing a beer with his friends at Possum Corner Hunting Club; and

1           WHEREAS, Charles Wiley Wilson is survived by his loving wife of sixty-four years,  
2 Judith Caffery Wilson; children, Angela Wade (Ted), Charles Frank Wilson (Lynn), Susan  
3 Causey, and Teresa Andrews (Charles); grandchildren, Lesleigh Silvey (Ryan), Lauren Pike  
4 (Josh), Landon Wade (Amanda), Olivia Wilson, Alex Causey (Kourtney), Andy Causey  
5 (Carol), Caroline Causey (Bryce), Claire Norrell (Marcus), Chas Andrews, Cameron  
6 Andrews, and Cate Andrews; great-grandchildren, Ryleigh Silvey, Sadee Silvey, Georgia  
7 Pike, Whitley Pike, Charlie Wade, Tate Wade, Evelyn Causey, Caffery Causey, Chloe
