Abstract: Provides relative to the admissibility of autopsy photographs in criminal proceedings.

Proposed law provides that photographs taken during an autopsy are admissible in any criminal proceeding.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to the original bill:

1. Modify proposed law to provide that photographs taken during an autopsy are admissible in any criminal proceedings, rather than criminal proceedings that allege a violation of first or second degree murder.
2. Make technical changes.
