Amendments proposed by Representative Freeman to Engrossed House Bill No. 766 by Representative Freeman

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 25 through 28 in their entirety

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 12 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

5 ~~(4)~~(5) A health insurance issuer that limits the total amount paid by a covered
6 person through all cost-sharing requirements to no more than one hundred dollars per
7 filled prescription for any orally administered anti-cancer medication shall be
8 considered in compliance with this Section. For purposes of this
9 Paragraph, "cost-sharing requirements" shall include copayments, coinsurance,
10 deductibles, and any other amounts paid by the covered person for that prescription.

11 (6) A health coverage plan shall not impose any prior authorization, dollar
12 limit, copayment, deductible, coinsurance, specialty tier placement, formulary
13 classification, benefit category determination, or other cost-sharing or utilization
14 management requirement on orally administered anti-cancer medications that results
15 in greater out-of-pocket expense or more restrictive access than that imposed on
16 intravenously administered or injected anti-cancer medications by the health
17 insurance issuer. This provision applies to high-deductible health plan policies that
18 are eligible for use in conjunction with Health Savings Accounts (HSAs), Medical
19 Savings Accounts (MSAs), or other similar programs authorized under 26 U.S.C. §
20 220 et seq.
