A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the Louisiana Lottery Corporation on the occasion of its thirty-fifth anniversary; to acknowledge the contributions of the Louisiana Lottery to public education in the state of Louisiana; and to recognize Rose Hudson for twenty years of distinguished service as president and chief executive officer.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation was established in 1991 pursuant to Article XII, Section 6 of the Constitution of Louisiana and the Louisiana Lottery Corporation Law, and has faithfully served the citizens of Louisiana for thirty-five years; and

WHEREAS, Rose Hudson's leadership has been defined by a steadfast adherence to the core values of integrity, accountability, and transparency, setting the standard for excellence in public administration and inspiring those who serve alongside her.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Louisiana Lottery Corporation on the occasion of its thirty-fifth anniversary and does hereby acknowledge its contributions to public education in Louisiana through the Minimum Foundation Program.
