Subject: Desecration of Graves and Religious Institutions

 Provides relative to the desecration of graves and religious institutions

Current law provides for the crimes of desecration of graves and institutional vandalism; provides for a fine of no more than five hundred dollars, or a sentence of imprisonment of no more than six months, or both, for those convicted of desecration of graves and institutional vandalism. Proposed law increases the fine for convictions of institutional vandalism and desecration of graves to no more than \$1,000; provides that in addition to any penalties in current law, the court shall order a defendant to make restitution for damages sustained for desecration of graves or institutional vandalism.

The exact fiscal impact to is indeterminable, because it is unknown the number of fines that will be collected, and the fines imposed are optional and variable in nature.
