2 To commend Flau'jae Johnson for her accomplishments at Louisiana State University.

3 WHEREAS, it is most fitting to recognize Flau'jae Johnson for her outstanding  
4 achievements in athletics, leadership, and community service at Louisiana State University;

6 WHEREAS, Flau'jae Johnson enrolled at Louisiana State University in 2022 as an  
7 exceptional student-athlete and has since emerged as one of the most accomplished  
8 collegiate athletes in the nation; and

9 WHEREAS, as a freshman member of the LSU women's basketball team, Flau'jae  
10 played a vital role in leading the team to victory in the 2023 NCAA National Championship,  
11 contributing significantly as a starter on a historic championship roster; and

12 WHEREAS, throughout her collegiate career, Flau'jae has earned numerous  
13 individual honors, including Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year, multiple  
14 All-Southeastern Conference selections, and multiple All-American recognitions,  
15 culminating in her selection to the prestigious John R. Wooden All-America Team; and

16 WHEREAS, Flau'jae has further distinguished herself by representing the United  
17 States in international competition, earning a gold medal as a member of Team USA in the  
18 FIBA Women's AmeriCup; and

19 WHEREAS, beyond her accomplishments on the court, Flau'jae has demonstrated  
20 exemplary leadership and service, earning national recognition as the recipient of the Kay

1 Yow Servant Leader Award, which honors student-athletes who exemplify compassion,  
2 advocacy, and a commitment to community service; and

3 WHEREAS, Flau'jae's advocacy efforts, particularly in raising awareness for cancer  
4 research and her engagement with youth and community initiatives, have made a meaningful  
5 and lasting impact across Louisiana and beyond; and

6 WHEREAS, Flau'jae has excelled academically as a student in the LSU Honors  
7 College, pursuing a degree in nursing while maintaining a 4.0 grade point average,  
8 demonstrating discipline and commitment to academic excellence; and

9 WHEREAS, in addition to her achievements in athletics and academics, Flau'jae has  
10 used her platform as both a nationally recognized athlete and recording artist to inspire  
11 young people and promote positive community engagement; and

12 WHEREAS, Flau'jae has positioned herself as a leading figure in collegiate athletics  
13 through name, image, and likeness opportunities while maintaining a strong commitment to  
14 integrity, responsibility, and service; and

15 WHEREAS, Flau'jae Johnson is an outstanding student-athlete and community  
16 servant who has brought great pride to Louisiana State University and the state of Louisiana,  
17 and she is deserving of the highest recognition for her many achievements.
