1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete the House Committee Amendments adopted by the House Committee on Education
3 (#1399)

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" and before "(H)(2)" delete "R.S. 17:3138.12(F) and" and
6 insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(E), (F), and"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 5, after "applicability;" and before "and" insert "to provide for
9 effectiveness;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 8, after "Section 1." and before "(H)(2)" delete "R.S. 17:3138.12(F) and" and
12 insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(E), (F), and"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

15 "E. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, LA FIRST,
16 through the Board of Regents, shall be provided access to all data listed in
17 the data-sharing agreement developed with each state entity. Access to the
18 data of each entity listed in Paragraph (C)(1) of this Section shall be provided
19 through the office of technology services on equipment provided by the
20 office of technology services. Once the Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Public
21 Policy Center has been provided access to the data, the policy center shall
22 comply with all restrictions imposed by law on any of the data received that
23 is deemed confidential, privileged, or otherwise restricted, and any reports
24 that use the data shall be released or published only in a manner that
25 complies with the restrictions. Under no circumstances shall data housed in
26 the LA FIRST data system be sold to third parties."

27 AMENDMENT NO. 6

28 On page 1, delete lines 16 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert the
29 following:

30 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 17:3914 or any other law
31 to the contrary, each city, parish, or other local public school board public
32 school governing authority shall directly share, at least annually, student data
33 with the Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Public Policy Center and any
34 department listed in Subsection C of this Section in order to carry out the
35 provisions of this Section and the goals of the data-sharing agreements: for
36 use in the LA FIRST data system.

37 (3)(a) To facilitate the sharing of a portion of this student personal
38 information, each public school governing authority shall directly share
39 personal information for high school students with the state Department of

1 Education, which shall share such information with the Kathleen Babineaux
2 Blanco Public Policy Center in order to carry out the provisions of this
3 Section."

4 AMENDMENT NO. 7

5 On page 2, at the beginning of line 9, change "(4)" to "(b)"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 8

7 On page 2, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

8 "(c) The state Department of Education shall develop and implement
9 a process for parents to opt out of the information sharing process provided
10 for in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph upon registration as part of an
11 existing data sharing information notice or parental consent process."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 9

13 On page 2, line 20, after "nonpersonal information." and before "Personal" insert "Personal
14 information and nonpersonal information shall be transferred and stored separately."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 10

16 On page 2, line 21, after "or" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 22 and 23 and
17 at the beginning of line 24, delete "after the unique identifier has been assigned." and insert
18 "to produce generalized or aggregated information to support analysis. A limited set of
19 nonpersonal information may be incorporated into the matching process."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 11

21 On page 3, line 3, after "17:3138.12" and before "with" insert "matched to unique student
22 identification numbers"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 12

24 On page 3, line 4, delete "R.S. 17:3138.12" and insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(F)"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 13

26 On page 3, after line 18, insert the following:

27 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on November 30, 2026."
