Proposed law provides for criteria for issuing alerts for AMBER, Level II Endangered Missing Child Advisory, and Silver Alert. Proposed law provides for the responsibilities of local law enforcement and state police. Proposed law provides that the Department of Public Safety and Corrections (State Police) shall make training available to local law enforcement on responses to reports of missing children, individuals with developmental disabilities, and senior citizens, including utilization of applicable alert systems. Proposed law shall be named and may be cited as "Bryan's Call".

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law establishes criteria and directs the Department of public Safety (DPS) to activate an AMBER Alert or a Level II Endangered Missing Child Advisory, depending on Louisiana State Police's (LSP) final determination, for abduction cases involving children seventeen (17) years of age or under when the circumstances indicate the child is in danger of serious bodily harm or death and there is sufficient descriptive information about the child, abductor, or suspect's vehicle(s), as well as to make available training for law enforcement officers. Any expenditures incurred by DPS can be absorbed with existing resources. Additionally, LSP and the Office of Technology Services (OTS) collaborated to determine that implementation of this proposed law will require only process changes and will use existing systems and technology. Also, LSP has determined that the proposed law would not require any IT-related upgrades, modifications, and/or acquisitions; the current technology used for the AMBER and Silver Alert and Level II Endangered Missing Child Advisory will remain the same in the event this proposed law is enacted.
