1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Tuesday, April 21, 2026, as Wholesalers Day at the Louisiana State Capitol
3 and to commend the Louisiana Association of Wholesalers for its contributions to
4 the economy and residents of Louisiana.

5 WHEREAS, wholesalers play a critical role in Louisiana's economy by serving as
6 the essential link between manufacturers and retailers, ensuring the efficient and reliable
7 distribution of goods throughout the state; and

9 of businesses that support local economies, create jobs, and contribute significantly to the
10 economic strength and stability of Louisiana; and
