
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works
to Original House Bill No. 1000 by Representative Braud

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "specify" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 6 and 7 in their
3 entirety, and insert "deadlines for final construction program submission;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the beginning of line 8, delete "following year;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 9, after "facilities;" and before "and" insert "to provide an effective date;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 3, after line 4, insert the following:

10 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
11 or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
12 without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the
13 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
14 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
