

1 WHEREAS, Caleb was a founding member of the 110 Brass Band, and he performed
2 for Mademoiselle Dwyn's School of Dance, various cotillions, and other events; he was a
3 member of Nu Phi Omicron, Inc., a nonprofit organization that helps Louisiana's college and
4 high school musicians grow and excel in their craft; and

5 WHEREAS, Caleb was a member of the National Honor Society, student council,
6 and the Warren Easton baseball team; he competed on the New Orleans Recreation
7 Department (NORD) swim team and worked as a NORD lifeguard; and

8 WHEREAS, at the time of his passing, Caleb was a junior majoring in mechanical
9 engineering at Southern University and A&M College in Baton Rouge; he was a member
10 of the National Society of Black Engineers and a junior usher and active member of Pilgrim
11 Baptist Church's Youth Ministry; and

12 WHEREAS, Caleb was able to live out his dream as a member of the Southern
13 University Band, and he performed and marched on the field of the Caesars Superdome
14 during Super Bowl LIX; he also played during the nationally-televised "Bayou Classic"
15 games in New Orleans; and

16 WHEREAS, Caleb is survived by his parents, Corey and Urania Wilson; siblings,
17 Coren and Corey, Jr.; grandmothers, Eulalia Porter and Veronica Temple; grandfather,
18 Albert Brown; godparents, Reverend Richard Eugene Wilson, Yolanda Curtis Wilson, Alicia
19 Alexander, and Jeffrey Alexander; and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, extended relatives,
20 and friends; he will be deeply missed, but his memory shall live on in the hearts and minds
21 of those who were privileged to have known him.

22 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
23 designate February 27, 2025, as Caleb Wilson Day in Louisiana; does hereby posthumously
24 commend Caleb's inspiring legacy as a mentor, musician, and scholar; and does hereby
25 recognize that the spirit of his music and the legacy of his love shall never fade.
