HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 184

A RESOLUTION

To designate Tuesday, April 21, 2026, as Junior League Day at the state capitol and to commend the Junior League for its contributions to Louisiana.

WHEREAS, the Junior League is an organization whose mission is to advance women's leadership for meaningful community impact through volunteer action, collaboration, and training; and

WHEREAS, the Junior Leagues of Baton Rouge, Greater Covington, Lafayette, Monroe, New Orleans, and Shreveport-Bossier are made up of several thousand members who work to have a positive impact on the lives of residents across Louisiana; and
