LOCAL AGENCIES. Provides for local ethics entities. (8/1/26)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:9612.2, relative to local ethics entities; to provide for the use of taxes

3 imposed for local ethics entities; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 33:9612.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§9612.2. Allocation of funds**

7 **Any tax levied and imposed by a local governmental subdivision for a**

8 **local ethics entity may be allocated by the entity to any local agency under the**

9 **jurisdiction of the entity to ensure compliance with state law.**

Present law authorizes certain local governmental subdivisions to establish local ethics entities.

Proposed law provides that any tax levied and imposed by a local governmental subdivision for a local ethics entity may be allocated by the entity to any local agency under the jurisdiction of the entity to ensure compliance with state law.

Effective August 1, 2026.
