DISTRICT ATTORNEYS/ASST OR +\$354,744 GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides for an increase in the dollar amount in warrants to provide for the salaries of assistant district attorneys

Current law provides that, effective 7/01/21, assistant district attorneys statewide are to receive an annual salary of \$50,000 payable monthly. Proposed law increases the salary of the assistant district attorneys to \$50,500 beginning 7/01/26.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in an increase of \$354,744 in SGF expenditures in FY 27 and subsequent fiscal years for annual salary increases for 624 assistant district attorneys (ADAs) throughout the state. The corresponding increase is associated with an increase in salaries (\$312,000) and related benefits (\$42,744) as follows:
