Current law provides for the number of assistant district attorneys in the 42 judicial districts within the state (624). Proposed law increases the number of assistant district attorneys in the judicial districts of the state by one assistant district attorney for each district.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in an increase of \$2.4 M in SGF expenditures in FY 27 and subsequent fiscal years for an increase of a total for 42 assistant district attorneys (ADAs) statewide. The corresponding increase is associated with an increase in salaries (\$2,100,000) and related benefits (\$287,700) as follows:
