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Provides for preference given to Louisiana seafood by purchasing agents of the state

Proposed law requires any person acting as a purchasing agent for the state to purchase seafood that is taken, harvested, or landed in Louisiana, provided that the cost of such seafood does not exceed the cost of seafood obtained from outside the state by more than 10%. Proposed measure includes an exception when sufficient quantities of Louisiana-sourced seafood are not available.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in state and local government expenditures. Proposed law requires any person acting as a purchasing agent for a state or local governmental entity, including any agency, board, commission, department, parish, municipality, or other political subdivision, to purchase seafood that is taken, harvested, or landed in Louisiana, provided that the cost of such seafood does not exceed the cost of seafood obtained from outside the state by more than 10%. To the extent that the requirements of proposed law overlap with the provisions of La R.S. 39:1604, the LFO assumes no impact. Proposed legislation provides an exception when sufficient quantities of seafood taken, harvested, or landed in Louisiana are not available.
