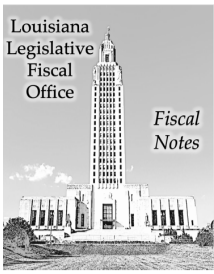

Extends moratorium on nursing facilities

Present law requires the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) to establish a facility need review process to determine if there is a need for any new nursing facilities or additional beds. It also provides for a nursing facility moratorium, with certain exceptions, to be in effect until 7/01/27.

Proposed law retains present law but extends the moratorium until 7/01/31.

Proposed law requires LDH to collect and analyze data and information from nursing facilities and hospitals beginning 1/01/2027 to assess the necessity of the nursing home moratorium. It further requires LDH to submit a monthly report of the information collected to the House and Senate Health and Welfare committees beginning 2/15/2027.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in a workload increase for the Office of Aging and Adult Services (OAAS) within Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) associated with additional reporting and analysis of data from nursing facilities and hospitals to assess the necessity of the ongoing nursing facility moratorium. LDH reports that it can absorb this workload impact with existing budgetary and staffing resources.

The Health Standards Section (HSS) within LDH anticipates no fiscal impact from extending the nursing facility moratorium through 7/01/2031. LDH is also required to submit its findings in a monthly report to the House and Senate Health and Welfare committees starting 2/15/2027.
