
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2026 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Reengrossed House Bill No. 675 by Representative Riser

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "Highway";" insert "to designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 121
3 in the parish of Rapides as the "Sheriff William Earl Hilton Memorial Highway";"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 7 change "Section 1." to section "Section 1.(A)"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 10 change "Section 2." to section "(B)"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, after line 14, insert the following:

10 "Section 2.(A) The portion of Louisiana Highway 121 beginning at the intersection
11 of Louisiana Highway 112 in Hineston, Louisiana, extending to Louisiana Highway 28, in
12 Gardner, Louisiana, all situated in Rapides Parish shall be known and is hereby designated
13 as the "Sheriff William Earl Hilton Memorial Highway".

14 (B) The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are hereby
15 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local
16 or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual cost for
17 material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum
18 of seven hundred fifty dollars per sign.

19 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
20 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
21 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
22 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
23 effective on the day following such approval."
