Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Original Senate Bill No. 347

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "17:3399.12(5)" insert "and 3399.16(A), (B), and (C)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "17:3399.12(5)" delete "is" and insert "and 3399.16(A), (B), and (C)  
5 are"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 11, after "Power-based" delete "violence" and insert "~~violence~~ **conduct**"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, delete line 12 and insert the following:

10 "intended to control, **coerce, harm, exploit** or intimidate another person on the basis  
11 of sex through the assertion of power or authority over"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, line 13, after "and" insert "**which**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 3, line 4, after "(14:285" insert "**(A)(1) and (A)(4)**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 7

17 On page 3, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

18 "§3399.16. Safety education; recognition and reporting of potential threats to safety  
19 A. Not later than the beginning of the fall semester of ~~2022~~ **2026**, the administration  
20 of each institution, ~~in consultation with campus or local law enforcement agencies,~~ shall  
21 ~~develop and distribute,~~ **not less than four times per academic year through in-person or**  
22 **online delivery or both,** information to students regarding power-based violence, campus  
23 safety, and internet and cell phone safety and online content that is a potential threat to  
24 school safety.

25 B. The information shall include the following:

26 (1) Instruction on ~~how to identify and~~ **the identification, prevent prevention,**  
27 **dangers, and prohibition of** power-based violence and how to detect potential threats to  
28 school safety exhibited online, including on any social media platform.

29 (2) How to report incidents of power-based violence, crimes on campus, violations  
30 of the student code of conduct, and possible threats to campus safety.

31 (3) Where to find reports regarding campus safety.

32 **(4) The information required in this Subsection shall be updated in consultation**  
33 **with campus or local law enforcement.**

34 C.**(1)** The information shall be distributed as part of new student orientation and shall  
35 be posted on an easily accessible page of each institution's website.

36 **(2) If the student receiving the information required by Subsections (B) and (C)**  
37 **of this Section is a minor, the information shall also be provided to his parent or legal**  
38 **guardian.**
