Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 763 by Representative Billings

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert the following:

3 A. As used in this Section, the following terms shall have the following
4 meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

5 (1) "Agency" means any state office, department, board, commission,
6 institution, division, officer or other person, or other organizational unit of
7 government within the executive branch of state government.

8 (2) "Settlement agreement" means a final"

10 On page 2, delete lines 13 through 27 in their entirety

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

12 On page 2, at the beginning of line 28, delete "D. Each state agency" and insert "C. Each
13 agency"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 3, line 4, after "by the" and before "agency." delete "state"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 3, at the beginning of line 5, change "E." to "D."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 3, between lines 7 and 8 insert the following:

20 "E. An agency may apply to the commissioner for a waiver from the
21 requirements of this Section as long as the agency maintains a publicly accessible
22 database or website that the commissioner deems to include information regarding
23 settlement agreements that is substantially similar to the information required
24 pursuant to the provisions of this Section. The commissioner shall ensure that a link
25 to each of these publicly accessible databases and websites is included on the website
26 established pursuant to the provisions of this Section."
