Myers

Amends the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections rule relative to criminal history checks for licensed ambulance personnel and nonlicensed persons to suspend implementation of the requirement for resubmission of a fingerprint background check to the to the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information when the result of a name-based background check contains possible arrest information until Oct. 1, 2026.

Directs the La. Register to incorporate the amended rule into the La. Administrative Code.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

1. Suspends implementation of the rule until Oct. 1, 2026.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Authorizes parish and local law enforcement agencies to perform criminal history checks and return applicable criminal history information to an authorized agency until Oct. 1, 2026.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to the reengrossed bill:

1. Remove proposed law that authorizes parish and local law enforcement agencies to perform criminal history checks and return applicable criminal history information to an authorized agency until Oct. 1, 2026.
