Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 1084

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" delete the remainder of the line and insert "enact R.S. 17:3384,  
3 relative to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 18 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert the following:

6 "Section 1. R.S. 17:3384 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §3384. Public postsecondary education institutions; tuition and fee authority  
8 and autonomy

9 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, each  
10 public postsecondary education institution may to establish and adjust tuition  
11 and fee amounts for all programs offered by the institution, including  
12 granting certificates, degrees, diplomas, or other credentials of value. This  
13 authority includes establishing tuition and fee amounts for part-time students,  
14 dual enrollment students, and students enrolled in summer and intersession  
15 terms.

16 B. When establishing tuition and fee amounts, each public  
17 postsecondary education institution shall, at a minimum, consider the  
18 following:

19 (1) Tuition and fee amounts of peer institutions.

20 (2) Median household income in Louisiana and in states where peer  
21 institutions are located.

22 (3) Affordability.

23 (4) Total cost of attendance.

24 C. Each public postsecondary education institution shall establish a  
25 process for providing adequate notice to students of tuition and fee amounts.  
26 Prior to imposing any increase in tuition and fee amounts pursuant to this  
27 Section, each institution shall establish criteria for waivers in cases of  
28 financial hardship. Such information shall be made available to all current  
29 and prospective students affected by the increase in a timely manner.

30 D. Each public postsecondary education institution shall submit a  
31 written report to its management board, the Board of Regents, the House  
32 Committee on Education, the Senate Committee on Education, the House  
33 Committee on Appropriations, and the Senate Committee on Finance not  
34 later than February fifteenth annually regarding how the tuition and  
35 mandatory fees authorized by this Section are being implemented."
