
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2026 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Original House Bill No. 1089 by Representative Bamburg

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, at the end of line 4, change "Services." to "Services and any necessary travel
3 expenses related to the procurement of any such product or service."

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, at the end of line 23, insert "However, the third-party administrator is not subject
6 to liability if the judgment creditor effectuates a transaction for items or services that are not
7 qualifying medical expenses using funds in a CARE Account."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, between lines 23 and 24, insert the following:

10 "(3) Prior to depositing funds into a CARE Account, the judgment debtor
11 shall require the judgment creditor to execute an affidavit attesting to his knowledge
12 and understanding that the funds in the account shall only be used for the purchase
13 of qualifying medical expenses."
