1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Monday, May 4, 2026, as Disability Awareness Day at the Louisiana State
3 Capitol and to recognize the contributions, rights, and dignity of individuals with
4 disabilities.

5 WHEREAS, the state of Louisiana is committed to promoting accessibility,
6 inclusion, and opportunity for all its citizens, including individuals with disabilities; and

7 WHEREAS, more than one in four adults in Louisiana live with a disability,
8 contributing significantly to the cultural, economic, and civic fabric of our state; and

9 WHEREAS, individuals with disabilities face daily barriers in transportation,
10 healthcare, education, employment, and public infrastructure that require greater awareness
11 and action; and

12 WHEREAS, the disability community exemplifies resilience, strength, and
13 determination, and reminds us that anyone's life can change in a split second; and

14 WHEREAS, organizations like the Split Second Foundation and the Governor's
15 Advisory Council on Disability Affairs work tirelessly to promote inclusion, accessibility,
16 and increase the quality of life for Louisianians with disabilities; and

18 lawmakers, and community leaders to learn from and uplift the voices of those living with
