1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Wednesday, April 29, 2026, as Gulf States Renewable Energy Industries
3 Association Day at the state capitol and to commend the association and Project
4 Vanguard.

5 WHEREAS, the Gulf States Renewable Energy Industries Association (GSREIA)
6 is the trade association of member companies leading in all parts of the renewable energy
7 supply chain; and

8 WHEREAS, GSREIA members provide good Louisiana jobs, local property tax
9 revenue, and economic benefits to the state's local communities; and

10 WHEREAS, Project Vanguard is the nation's premier veteran-led network that
11 connects transitioning service members and veterans to meaningful careers across the entire
12 American energy sector from oil and gas to renewables, nuclear, and beyond; and

13 WHEREAS, GSREIA and Project Vanguard work with a diverse array of companies
14 throughout the supply chain, including manufacturers, suppliers, distributors, developers of
15 energy systems and components, and providers of installation, maintenance, and grid
16 integration services; and

17 WHEREAS, GSREIA and Project Vanguard support the continued deployment of
18 renewable energy resources, strengthening grid reliability, and contributing to long-term
19 economic investment and job creation in the state; and

1 WHEREAS, GSREIA and Project Vanguard have fostered expansion of the sector
2 across utility-scale, commercial, and residential energy generation and storage, which creates
3 jobs and supports economic development; and

4 WHEREAS, GSREIA and Project Vanguard promote the expansion of new energy
5 generation and strengthening of the region's renewable energy infrastructure; these efforts
6 contribute to Louisiana's energy security and resilience, particularly in the face of natural
7 disasters; and

8 WHEREAS, GSREIA includes companies across the nation and the Gulf Coast
9 region, from small businesses to Fortune 500 companies, and stimulates sustainable
10 economic growth by supporting workforce development, removing market barriers, and
11 promoting innovation.
