Subject: Housing of Inmates Committed to Corrections		

CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to the housing of inmates committed to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections

Current law provides that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any individual subject to confinement in a state adult penal or correctional institution shall be committed to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and not to any particular institution within the jurisdiction of the department; provides that the secretary of the department may transfer an inmate from one such facility to another, insofar as the transfer is consistent with the commitment and in accordance with treatment, training, and security needs established by the department. Proposed law prohibits the Department of Public Safety and Corrections from housing an inmate more than 30 miles outside of either (1) the parish where the criminal offense occurred or where the inmate was convicted or (2) the parish where the residence or domicile of the inmate is located.
