Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 632

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" and before "(H)(2)" delete "R.S. 17:3138.12(F) and" and
3 insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(E), (F), and"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "applicability;" and before "and" insert "to provide for
6 effectiveness;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "Section 1." and before "(H)(2)" delete "R.S. 17:3138.12(F) and" and
9 insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(E), (F), and"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

12 "E. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, LA FIRST,
13 through the Board of Regents, shall be provided access to all data listed in the data-
14 sharing agreement developed with each state entity. Access to the data of each entity
15 listed in Paragraph (C)(1) of this Section shall be provided through the office of
16 technology services on equipment provided by the office of technology services.
17 Once the Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Public Policy Center has been provided access
18 to the data, the policy center shall comply with all restrictions imposed by law on any
19 of the data received that is deemed confidential, privileged, or otherwise restricted,
20 and any reports that use the data shall be released or published only in a manner that
21 complies with the restrictions. Under no circumstances shall data housed in the LA
22 FIRST data system be sold to third parties."

23 AMENDMENT NO. 5

24 On page 1, delete lines 16 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert the
25 following:

26 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 17:3914 or any other law to the
27 contrary, each city, parish, or other local public school board public school
28 governing authority shall directly share, at least annually, student data with the
29 Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Public Policy Center and any department listed in
30 Subsection C of this Section in order to carry out the provisions of this Section and
31 the goals of the data-sharing agreements. for use in the LA FIRST data system.

32 (3)(a) To facilitate the sharing of a portion of this student personal
33 information, each public school governing authority shall directly share personal
34 information for high school students with the state Department of Education, which
35 shall share such information with the Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Public Policy
36 Center in order to carry out the provisions of this Section."

37 AMENDMENT NO. 6

38 On page 2, at the beginning of line 9, change "(4)" to "(b)"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 7

2 On page 2, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

3 "(c) The state Department of Education shall develop and implement
4 a process for parents to opt out of the information sharing process provided
5 for in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph upon registration as part of an
6 existing data sharing information notice or parental consent process."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 8

8 On page 2, line 20, after "nonpersonal information." and before "Personal" insert "Personal
9 information and nonpersonal information shall be transferred and stored separately."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 9

11 On page 2, line 21, after "or" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 22 and 23 and
12 at the beginning of line 24, delete "after the unique identifier has been assigned." and insert
13 "to produce generalized or aggregated information to support analysis. A limited set of
14 nonpersonal information may be incorporated into the matching process."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 10

16 On page 3, line 3, after "17:3138.12" and before "with" insert "matched to unique student
17 identification numbers"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 11

19 On page 3, line 4, delete "R.S. 17:3138.12" and insert "R.S. 17:3138.12(F)"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 12

21 On page 3, after line 18, insert the following:

22 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on November 30, 2026."
