Provides for limitations on recovery of attorney fees and costs in occupational licensing board disciplinary hearings. (8/1/26)

Proposed law amends R.S.37.21(B) professions and occupations laws. Proposed law provides that when a professional or occupational board initiates disciplinary action against a licensee and the final resolution of the proceeding before the board results in a consent, judgement or finding that is less severe than the offer of judgement, the board is precluded from recovering costs and attorney fees from the licensee.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Officials from the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, Louisiana State Board of Dentistry, Louisiana State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners, Louisiana State Board of Nursing, Louisiana State Board of Pharmacy, and Louisiana State Board of Certified Public Accountants do not anticipate any additional expenses as a result of the proposed law.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable potential decrease in self-generated revenues for the following boards: Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, Louisiana State Board of Dentistry, Louisiana State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, Louisiana State Board of Social Work Examiners, Louisiana State Board of Nursing, Louisiana State Board of Pharmacy, and Louisiana State Board of Certified Public Accountants.

Under the provisions of the proposed law, boards will no longer be able to recover certain legal costs and attorney fees in disciplinary cases where the final judgment, consent, or finding is less severe than the board's original offer. Officials from the affected boards have indicated that such scenarios rarely occur; therefore, the impact on revenues is expected to be minimal but indeterminable.
