Subject: Prohibits PA requirements for certain generic medications		

INSURANCE RE NO IMPACT GF EX See Note Page 1 of 1
 Prohibits prior authorizations requirements for certain generic medications prescribed by qualified physicians

Proposed law adds definitions for the terms "board-certified physician," "commercial insurer," "generic medication," and "prior authorization" to present law. Proposed law provides that the term "commercial insurer" shall not include federal, state, or local governmental health plans. Proposed law prohibits a commercial insurer from requiring prior authorization (PA) for the dispensing or reimbursement of a generic medication that is not an opioid, if the prescription for the medication is issued by a board-certified physician whose specialty certification includes the medical indication for which the drug is prescribed and the wholesale acquisition cost is no more than \$250 per prescription.

Proposed law applies to any new policy, contract, or health coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2027. Any policy, contract, or health coverage plan contract in effect prior to January 1, 2027, shall convert to conform to the provisions of proposed law no later than January 1, 2028.
