Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Reengrossed House Bill No. 511 by Representative Glorioso

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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "40:2401.4" and before the comma "," insert "and 2401.5"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 5, after "Plan;" and before "to require" insert the following:

5 "to establish the Pursuit Safety and Officer Technology Fund as a special  
6 fund in the state treasury; to provide for the transfer, deposit, and use, as specified,  
7 of monies in the Pursuit Safety and Officer Technology Fund;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 8, after "2401.4" and before "hereby" delete "is" and insert "and 2401.5 are"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

12 "§2401.5. Pursuit Safety and Officer Technology Fund

13 A. There is hereby established in the state treasury, as a special fund, the  
14 Pursuit Safety and Officer Technology Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section  
15 as the "fund".

16 B. After allocation of monies to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund as  
17 provided in Article VII, Section (9)(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, the treasurer  
18 shall deposit into the fund monies transferred, appropriated, or dedicated to the fund.  
19 Monies in the fund shall be appropriated by the legislature to the Louisiana  
20 Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Criminal Justice and  
21 shall be used solely for the following purposes:

22 (1) Provide grants to state, parish, and municipal law enforcement agencies  
23 for the acquisition of pursuit intervention technology, including but not limited to  
24 GPS tracking projectiles, remote-deployment tire deflation devices, and  
25 vehicle-tethering systems.

26 (2) Provide grants to state, parish, and municipal law enforcement agencies  
27 for the development and implementation of training programs for the safe  
28 deployment of pursuit intervention devices and technology.

29 (3) Administrative costs of the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement  
30 and the Administration of Criminal Justice associated with the grant program, not to  
31 exceed five percent of the annual fund balance.

32 C. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the  
33 state general fund. Interest earned on investment of monies in the fund shall be  
34 credited to the fund. Unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end  
35 of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund."
