

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2026 Regular Session

Substitute for Original House Bill No. 123 by Representative Bayham as proposed by the House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice

This document reflects the content of a substitute bill but is not in a bill form; page numbers in this document DO NOT correspond to page numbers in the substitute bill itself.

1 To amend and reenact R.S. 15:835(D), relative to electronic monitoring; to provide for
2 prohibitions relative to ownership or financial interests in electronic monitoring
3 service providers; to provide for a definition; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 15:835(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6 §835. Registration of electronic monitoring service providers

7 * * *

8 D.(1) ~~An elected official, or any immediate family member of an elected~~
9 official, shall be prohibited from being a vendor, or having No elected judge, district
10 attorney, sheriff, nor any immediate family member of these individuals shall have
11 an ownership interest or a financial interest in a vendor, for any company that
12 provides electronic monitoring services in this state.

13 (2) For the purposes of this Subsection, "immediate family member" has the
14 same meaning as in R.S. 42:1102.

HB Draft 2026 Regular Session

Abstract: Prohibits certain individuals from having an ownership or financial interest in electronic monitoring providers in the state of La.

Present law provides for registration of electronic monitoring service providers.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law prohibits an elected official, or any immediate family member of an elected official, from being a vendor or having a financial interest in a vendor for electronic monitoring services in the state of La.

Proposed law amends present law to apply this prohibition only to elected judges, district attorneys, sheriffs, and any immediate family member of these individuals.

Proposed law defines the term "immediate family member".
