HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 191

HIGHWAYS: Urges and requests the Department of Transportation and Development to study the need for and safety of mountable median curbs on Range Avenue in Denham Springs, Louisiana

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to study the
3 installation of and considerations for safety data supporting mountable median curbs,
4 including alternative options, on Range Avenue in Denham Springs, Louisiana.

5 WHEREAS, Range Avenue is a major commercial and transportation corridor in
6 Denham Springs, Louisiana; and

7 WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding whether sufficient right-of-way
8 was available for proper installation of the mountable median curbs; and

9 WHEREAS, the local business community has questions regarding what
10 consideration was given to businesses and the effects on commerce along the corridor; and

11 WHEREAS, there is a need to ascertain whether safety data supports the installation
12 of the mountable median curbs; and

13 WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding possible alternative options that
14 could have been implemented with similar safety outcomes.

15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
16 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Transportation and
17 Development to study the installation of and considerations for safety data supporting
18 mountable median curbs, including alternative options, on Range Avenue in Denham
19 Springs, Louisiana.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation and
2 Development shall submit a written report detailing its findings to the House Committee on
3 Transportation, Highways and Public Works on or before December 1, 2026.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
5 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
