A RESOLUTION

To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Dr. Johnny Earl Drumgole, Sr.

WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound regret that the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana has learned of the passing, on April 27, 2026, of Dr. Johnny Earl Drumgole, Sr.; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Drumgole was born and raised in Monroe, Louisiana, and was a 1969 graduate of Carroll High School, where he starred as a running back on the football team; he maintained a strong connection with the city throughout his life; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Drumgole and his wife, Dr. Pamela Cage-Drumgole, began hosting a Bible study in their home in 1979 and founded Liberty Christian Center on August 8, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Drumgole fully transitioned into ministry in 1982, after a distinguished career at General Motors; under his stewardship, Liberty Christian Center enjoyed growth and stability and expanded its facilities; and

WHEREAS, outside of ministry, Dr. Drumgole was involved in local education and social services; he founded Excelsior Christian School and advocated for youth mentorship to challenge young men to pursue higher education and personal excellence; he held leadership roles with the Northeast Louisiana Food Bank, Habitat for Humanity, and numerous regional ministerial alliances; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnny Earl Drumgole, Sr., is survived by his wife, Dr. Pamela Cage-Drumgole; his children, Daphne Drumgole, Jasmine Drumgole, and Johnny Drumgole, Jr.; and his grandchildren; he will be deeply missed, but the legacy of his ministerial and community service shall live on in the hearts and minds of those who were privileged to have known and loved him.
