Abstract: Requires the notice for a local or special law caused to be published by a person other than a member of the legislature to include the name of the person who caused the notice to be published.

Present constitution (Const. Art. III, Section 13(A)) provides that no local or special law shall be enacted unless notice of the intent to introduce a bill to enact such a law has been published on two separate days, without cost to the state, in the official journal of the locality where the matter to be affected is situated. The last day of publication shall be at least thirty days prior to introduction of the bill.

Proposed House Rule provides that a notice of the intent to introduce a bill to enact a local or special law that is caused to be published by a person other than a member of the legislature shall include the name of the person who caused the notice to be published.
