Present law provides that the effective date of Act No. 670 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature is contingent on decisions being issued by the U.S. Supreme Court in certain cases.

Proposed law repeals present law and provides that Act No. 670 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature will be effective on August 1, 2026.

Proposed law authorizes the division of administration to review state contracts to determine if they are held by a foreign adversary, a foreign terrorist organization, or the agents of a foreign adversary or of a foreign terrorist organization.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to the original bill

1. Delete proposed law pertaining to state contracts.
2. Provide an effective date for present law relative to unlawful entry into the state by an alien.
3. Authorize the division of administration to review state contracts for certain purposes.
4. Repeal effectiveness provisions of Act No. 670 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature relative to unlawful entry into the state by an alien.
5. Make technical changes.
