4 WHEREAS, it is most fitting to recognize Ty Hebert for his service to the Acadiana
5 Legislative Delegation and to commend him on the occasion of his graduation from
6 Louisiana State University; and

7 WHEREAS, Ty is graduating with a bachelor of science degree in agricultural
8 business from Louisiana State University on May 15, 2026; and

9 WHEREAS, Ty is a member of Kappa Sigma and served as fraternity president from
10 November 2024 to November 2025; he was nominated for Interfraternity Conference
11 President of the Year for his service; and

14 a leadership development workshop to benefit youth in agriculture; and

17 WHEREAS, Ty has displayed an outstanding work ethic, attention to detail, and
18 willingness to take on a wide range of responsibilities during his time with the Acadiana
