HIGHWAYS: Redesignates the elevated portion of Interstate 220 in Caddo Parish as the "American Legion Post No. 14 Memorial Bridge"

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds a designation of a portion of Louisiana Highway 173 as the "Dr. Harry Blake, Sr. Memorial Highway".
2. Clarifies that the cost of the signage for the "Dr. Harry Blake, Sr. Memorial Highway" designation cannot exceed \$750 per sign, instead of \$150 per sign.
3. Makes technical changes.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Redesignates an elevated portion of I-220 from S. Lakeshore Dr. to Hilry Huckaby III Ave. in Shreveport, La. as the "American Legion Post No. 14 Memorial Bridge".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of \$2,250 per sign.

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 173 from Elder St. and N. Holtzman Ave. to Common St. in Shreveport, La. as the "Dr. Harry Blake, Sr. Memorial Highway".

Directs the DOTD to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of the signage, not to exceed the sum of \$750 per sign.
