CIVIL/VENUE: Provides for venue with respect to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System.

DIGEST

Present law (C.C.P. Art. 84) requires actions involving the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System ("MPERS") to be brought in the parish of East Baton Rouge ("EBRP") or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program.

Proposed law provides that if the defendant is the MPERS or its board of trustees, the action shall be brought in EBRP or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program.

Proposed law provides that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, if the MPERS or its board of trustees is the plaintiff, the action shall be brought only in the district court having jurisdiction in the parish in which the cause of action arises.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to the engrossed bill

1. Makes technical changes.
2. Provides that if the defendant is the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System or its board of trustees, the action shall be brought in East Baton Rouge Parish or in the parish of the domicile of the retirement system or employee benefit program.
3. Provides that if the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System or its board of trustees is the plaintiff, the action shall be brought only in the district court having jurisdiction in the parish in which the cause of action arises.
