**PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Provides relative to the selling of state-owned surplus movable property.**

DIGEST

Present law authorizes the commissioner of administration to sell state-owned surplus movable property at public auction. Authorizes the commissioner of administration to hire qualified licensed auctioneers to handle the sale at a live public auction. Further authorizes the commissioner to sell surplus movable property through the use of electronic technology at an internet computer auction.

Proposed law gives a preference for an in-state auctioneer over an out-of-state auctioneer where services provided are equal in quality and do not exceed cost by more than 10% of services available from out-of-state auctioneers. Proposed law applies to live public auctions and internet computer auctions.
