HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 288

SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates May 22, 2026, as World Preeclampsia Awareness Day in Louisiana

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Friday, May 22, 2026, as World Preeclampsia Awareness Day in Louisiana.

3 WHEREAS, May is recognized nationally and internationally as Preeclampsia
4 Awareness Month and aims to increase understanding of this life-threatening hypertensive
5 disorder of pregnancy; and

6 WHEREAS, World Preeclampsia Day is observed annually on May twenty-second
7 to raise global awareness of preeclampsia, a serious pregnancy-related condition that poses
8 significant risks to maternal and infant health; and

9 WHEREAS, preeclampsia is most often characterized by a rapid rise in blood
10 pressure that can lead to seizure, stroke, multiple organ failure, and the death of the mother
11 and baby; and

12 WHEREAS, the United States currently ranks forty-seventh worldwide for maternal
13 mortality and is the only industrialized nation with a rising maternal mortality rate; and

14 WHEREAS, in the United States, preeclampsia complicates approximately one in
15 every twenty-five pregnancies; and

16 WHEREAS, in 2024, Louisiana recorded a maternal mortality rate of 41.9 deaths per
17 one hundred thousand live births, which is the highest rate in the nation; and

18 WHEREAS, according to America's Health Rankings, 18.3 percent of Louisiana
19 women between the ages of eighteen and forty-four have been diagnosed with high blood
20 pressure, placing Louisiana forty-sixth among all states; and

1 WHEREAS, sixty percent of hypertension-related maternal deaths are considered
2 potentially preventable with timely diagnosis, treatment, and coordinated care; and

3 WHEREAS, maternal death has profound and lasting emotional, social, and
4 economic impacts on families and communities throughout Louisiana; and

5 WHEREAS, the primary treatment for preeclampsia involves early delivery of the
6 infant to prevent disease progression and complications; and

7 WHEREAS, in 2024, Louisiana ranked fifty-first among the fifty states and Puerto
8 Rico for premature births, and preeclampsia is recorded as a significant contributing factor
9 to such births; and

10 WHEREAS, Louisiana continues to rank among the states with the highest infant
11 mortality rates in the United States, with nine deaths per one thousand live births compared
12 to the national average of 5.6, according to America's Health Rankings; and

13 WHEREAS, it is imperative that Louisiana address the prevalence of infant and
14 maternal mortality in the state and work to provide more effective care for the state's
15 expecting mothers and unborn children.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Friday, May 22, 2026, as World
18 Preeclampsia Awareness Day in Louisiana and does hereby acknowledge Woman's Hospital
19 for providing care to pregnant women to help reduce maternal and infant deaths and reduce
20 the number of pre-term births.
