

**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2026 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 367 by Senator Edmonds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "District;" and before "and to" insert "to provide for an effective  
3 date;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 12, after "to" and before "as the" insert "in this Section"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 15, after "Basin" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and insert the  
8 following "impacted by sand and gravel mining operations, with priority given to flood-  
9 prone areas and impaired watersheds."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, at the end of line 1, delete "any" and delete lines 2 and 3 in their entirety and  
12 insert the following:

13 "one hundred percent of the portion of recurring severance tax revenues  
14 collected on sand severed from within the geographic boundaries of the district  
15 that would have been deposited into the state general fund after allocations of  
16 such revenues otherwise required by the Constitution of Louisiana and the  
17 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. Monies designated for the fund and  
18 received by the state treasurer from donations, gifts, grants, or other revenue  
19 shall be deposited into the fund."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 12 in their entirety and insert the following:

22 "E. Monies in the fund shall be appropriated to the Coastal Protection  
23 and Restoration Authority for use by the board of commissioners for the Amite  
24 River Basin Drainage and Water Conservation District for use as provided in  
25 Subsection B of this Section.

26 F. An annual report detailing the receipts, expenditures, and funded  
27 activities of the Watershed Restoration and Conservation Fund shall be  
28 submitted by the board to the House Committee on Natural Resources and  
29 Environment and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources by March first  
30 of each calendar year.

31 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2026."
