Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to Reengrossed House Bill No. 769 by Representative Boyd

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 2, after "bail." delete the remainder of the line.

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 8 and insert:

5 "(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsubparagraph (a) of this
6 Subparagraph, a person charged with any crime listed in this Paragraph, and for
7 whom a determination of probable cause has been made, may be held without bail
8 for not less than forty-eight hours nor more than seventy-two hours following the
9 determination of probable cause. This holding period shall run concurrently with the
10 time period provided in Article 230.1.

11 (c) In deciding whether to impose the holding period authorized by
12 Subsubparagraph (b) of this Subparagraph, the court shall consider any facts
13 presented that indicate an increased risk to the victim, including but not limited to
14 stalking, strangulation, violation of a protective order, use or threatened use of force
15 or a deadly weapon, serious bodily injury, or documented threats to the victim, the
16 victim's family, or the public.

17 (d) The holding period provided for in Subsubparagraph (b) of this
18 Subparagraph may be referred to as a "cooling off" period for the"
