

1 WHEREAS, legislators value the contributions and insights of the members of the
2 Legislative Youth Advisory Council and would benefit from the council's discussion of
3 artificial intelligence issues affecting young people.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
5 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Legislative Youth Advisory
6 Council to discuss artificial intelligence issues that may affect young people in Louisiana.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the discussion may include topics such as the
8 education of students, parents and guardians, and teachers and other youth-serving
9 professionals regarding artificial intelligence as it pertains to matters facing Louisiana's
10 young people.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council may seek input from individuals with
12 knowledge of artificial intelligence impacting the lives of young people in Louisiana,
13 including but not limited to representatives of the office of the attorney general, law
14 enforcement, the state Department of Education, and the Louisiana Center for Safe Schools.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council may provide a summary of its
16 discussion of artificial intelligence to the Commission on Civic Education and the
17 legislature.
